- 2) The teachers should be paid in the scales of pay as applicable to the teachers in Government Schools.
- 3) The educational agency should run the school as a separate school with separate Headmaster and not an annex to the Hindu Higher Secondary School, Triplicane, Madras-5. and

to the fulfilment of the requirements stipulated by the board.


